It placed second with regard to cost and offering of funds. Its range of investment products which currently includes securities listed on the SWX, virt-x, NYSE, Nasdaq and Amex, as well as investment funds from CS, Pictet, Swissca and Vontobel earned it third place. We are proud to have succeeded in creating one of the first online banks, and furthermore that we managed to come out on top in comparison with traditional banks, remarked Alfred Moeckli, CEO of Swissquote Bank about this second victory.
